

Social Psychology Search 2024

Meeting Minutes • October 15, 2024, 10:00–11:10

Present: Friedl, García Ferrés, Levett, Rodriguez, and Webster

Summary. Co-chair Webster called meeting to order and discussed procedures for triaging applications described in the prior meeting's minutes (10/3). During the past week, each of the 75 applications received was reviewed thoroughly and independently by two committee members. On the basis of their scores (ranging from 0 to 2), the committee discussed and agreed to triage applications with mean scores < 1.5 . Applications in and around this score were discussed by committee, yielding a non-triaged list of 33 applications (top 44%). The committee also chose to have a third reader rate the remaining 33 applications to create some additional variance to help identify a "long short list" of roughly a dozen applicants to be Zoom interviewed later in October. At our next meeting, we'll attempt to identify a "long short list" and discuss standardized Zoom interview questions.
